Write-out & Workshop: Plan on writing for an hour. After a short break, writers can take turns reading what they have written or read five pages of a work-in-progress. Bringing a manuscript is not required. New writers may feel more comfortable reading after they get to know the group.

How to prepare a manuscript in advance, for *Write-out & Workshop Group*:

- Double-space, Times New Roman, 12-14 points.
 - Select five pages of your work to read.
- Bring six to eight copies for others to follow along and make comments.
 - Using blank sides of old manuscripts is fine.
 - Your copies will be returned to you that evening.
