

ORDINANCE NO. 228

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ANNETTA, TEXAS, PROHIBITING THE USE OR DETONATION OF FIREWORKS DURING A BURN BAN IMPLEMENTED BY THE PARKER COUNTY COMMISSIONER'S COURT; DECLARING THE USE OR DETONATION OF FIREWORKS WITHIN TOWN LIMITS TO BE A NUISANCE PURSUANT TO TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 217.022; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE IS CUMULATIVE; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a Class C misdemeanor upon conviction and shall be fined, except as otherwise provided herein, in a sum not to exceed Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) for each offense, and a separate offense shall be deemed committed upon each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
