Delgado Announces Congressional App Challenge, Calls for Submissions in NY-19

U.S. Representative Antonio Delgado (NY-19) announced this year's Congressional App Challenge and called for submissions from high school and middle school students across New York's 19th Congressional District. Last year's winning app was PaniChat by Cameron Johnson and Matthew Sweet, two students from Franklin D. Roosevelt High School in Hyde Park.

"I am pleased to announce my office is accepting submissions for this year's Congressional App Challenge," said Rep. Delgado. "As folks are adjusting to remote learning and spending more time online, the Congressional App Challenge is a great opportunity for upstate students to showcase their programming capabilities and gain experience writing code. Last year, I thoroughly enjoyed seeing the ideas submitted by our talented young people, and I encourage all eligible students in NY-19 to compete in this year's app challenge."

The Congressional App Challenge is open to all middle school and high school students who live in New York's 19th Congressional District. Students entering the competition must submit source code along with a YouTube or VIMEO video that explains and demonstrates their app and what they learned through the competition process.

The final deadline for submissions to this year's competition is Monday, Oct. 19. Students are encouraged to register and begin work on their projects as soon as possible. The winning individual or team will be featured on Delgado.house.gov and CongressionalAppChallenge.us, and the winning app will be placed on display in the U.S. Capitol alongside winners from across the country.

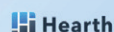

The Historical Society of the Town of Middletown (HSM), in collaboration with Margaretville Mountain Inn, invites the public to a short ceremony Sunday, Sept. 27 at 2 p.m. The Inn is located about two miles up Margaretville Mountain Road which begins as Walnut Street in the Village of Margaretville. This important site in Catskills' agricultural history was the former William and Thankful VanBenschoten farm overlooking the East Branch valley.

In the mid-1890s, 20 years after cauliflower began to be grown commercially on Long Island, William F. VanBenschoten, obtained 100 cauliflower plants from acquaintances there. His wife, Thankful Sanford VanBenschoten, reportedly nursed the first plants in flower pots in her kitchen. They did so well the following year and peddled the fresh cauliflower to boarding houses in Fleischmanns.

The year after that, they put in 2,000 plants, and began shipping the crop in iced barrels on trains to the New York City market. Soon, other local farmers began planting cauliflower and by the 19-teens the Catskills became renowned for its fine quality 'white gold.' This was a major industry here through the mid-20th century.

The Van Benschotens also kept a boarding house. They built their lovely Victorian home in 1890 to accommodate summer visitors. Listed on the state and national registers of historic places, Margaretville Mountain Inn still welcomes tourists and hosts weddings. It has been operated by Carol Molnar and family for 30 years.

This will be the eighth brown and yellow marker erected by HSM to design-

outlines side tours participants might take to view covered bridges and other historic sites. For more information and history, visit www.1903autorun.com.

along Route 28, the Catskill Mountains Scenic Byway. The rally celebrates the driving pioneers who competed in the 1903 Automobile Endurance Run. Some 50 cars of all eras, from Packards to Lotus, will enjoy the non-competitive 2020 ride along a 75-mile section of the historic route from Mt. Tremper to Unadilla.

The cars will travel at their own pace and, over time, will spread out along the route. 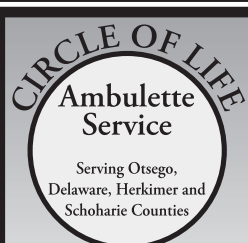

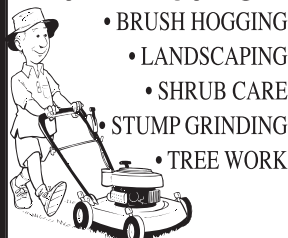

The Search Committee of the PHCC was struck that with so many young people leaving the region to seek good jobs, McMurray had returned home, eager to bring everything she'd learned and experienced with nonprofits to benefit the Catskills. Board President Jim Nevin welcomes "Colleen's exuberant warmth" and says, "her local roots will bring new energy and new insights to the Center in these challenging times. We are thrilled she's joining us. I'm confident that when you meet her, you will be as charmed and inspired by her as we are."

McMurray has returned to a Catskills whose needs and interests are changing and becoming more

diverse. "I think the PHCC truly listens to the wants and needs of residents and has given them a space where they can be heard. I want to immerse myself in the community and help it grow. I plan to be here long term."

Community members interested in meeting Colleen McMurray can sign up to attend the annual meeting of the PHCC, which will take Oct. 24 on Zoom.

Delgado, Tonko Lead NY Delegation Demanding Answers on Food Box Failures

U.S. Representatives Antonio Delgado (NY-19) and Paul D. Tonko (NY-20) led more than a dozen mem-

bers of New York's Congressional Delegation July 13 in a stern letter to Sonny Perdue, Secretary of the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA), demanding answers and public transparency over the agency's mishandling of the USDA Food Box program.

"Both our family farmers in upstate and most vulnerable populations have experienced dire consequences from the coronavirus pandemic and it is essential that the programs designed to assist both communities are transparent and good stewards of taxpayer dollars," said Rep. Delgado, a member of the House Agriculture Committee. "I authored this letter with Rep. Tonko to get the answers we need from the Trump Administration about how these contract decisions were made and their plans to ensure that going forward these resources are awarded in a transparent manner and in a way that ensures our region of the country is properly accounted for."

"Following several efforts by Congress and others to raise concerns with USDA, the Trump Administration could easily have remedied these issues of inequity and transparency," noted Rep. Tonko. "Instead they have chosen to double down on their obvious and puzzling mismanagement of this vital food assistance program

in the middle of our nation's worsening COVID-19 epidemic. I cannot fathom why USDA continues to exclude local food banks that are already set up to do this work in support of the neediest among us. Instead, USDA has chosen to award lucrative food distribution contracts to small out-of-state companies that have little or no presence or capacity here. This kind of mismanagement does real and lasting harm to the people and communities we serve, and USDA needs to answer for it."

Despite Congressional outreach and growing media attention on the issue, USDA continues to assign disproportionately few contracts to organizations covering the Northeastern United States. New York and New England together account for 10% of the national population but received just 4% of contract funding in the first round and even less in the second. Some areas have been overlooked entirely. For example, the Northeast Regional Food Bank, which serves 23 counties including Delaware County, was completely shut out of the second round of distribution contracts after only receiving one contract in the first. Food banks in service areas without contracts are being left to beg for contracts from vendors out of their area,

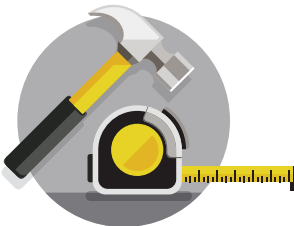

What to do to prepare your garden for winter

Gardens provide an idyllic escape from the hustle and bustle of everyday life. In fact, many gardening enthusiasts typically cannot wait for the spring thaw so they can spend the next several months tending to their plants under the warm sun. But a gardener's work is never truly done, and the work to make gardens stun in the spring actually begins during the preceding fall.

Preparing gardens for winter is an important step that can help homeowners ensure their gardens return to full strength in the spring. The tasks necessary to prepare gardens for winter may depend on what homeowners are planting, but the following are some general maintenance suggestions that can keep gardens safe this winter.



- Remove weeds and debris. Weeds and debris are unsightly and detrimental to plant life in spring, but they also can be harmful in the winter. Weeds and debris left to linger in gardens through the winter provide overwintering spots for insects and can contribute to disease. So it's imperative that weeds and debris are removed

before the ground hardens in winter. Don't wait until the ground hardens, as that can make it hard to remove the roots of weeds, adversely affecting the garden as a result.

- Prepare the soil. The Farmer's Almanac advises homeowners to gently till the soil in their gardens so they can expose any insects before they settle in for the winter. Once garden soil is exposed, add a layer of compost, leaves, aged manure, and, if necessary, lime, gently tilling it into the soil. According to the North Carolina Cooperative Extension, the only accurate way to determine if lawn or garden soil needs lime is to test it. Lime makes soil less acidic and reduces soil pH. Low soil pH makes it hard for certain plants to grow, but acidic soil is ideal when grow-

can make it hard for the garden to thrive in the spring.

- Protect fruit trees. If you have fruit trees, install mouse guards around the base to prevent mice and voles from killing the trees over the winter. If left to their own devices over the winter, mice and voles may eat the bark of fruit trees, killing the trees as a result. The Farmer's Almanac notes that mouse guards made of fine mesh hardware cloth can effectively protect fruit trees from hungry mice and voles over the winter.

A gardener's work is never done, and the work to create beautiful spring gardens begins in the fall.



time to prepare for upcoming projects that can make winter work that much easier. For example, fall is a great time to take stock of your gutters so you can address any issues before leaves begin to fall or the first snowstorm touches down. Compromised gutters can contribute to water issues in basements and adversely affect a home's foundation if not addressed immediately, so it behooves homeowners to learn the signs that gutters are in need of repair or replacement.

- Gutters hanging off the home: Gutters were once installed predominantly with spikes. However, many industry professionals now install gutters with hanger brackets. Why the change? Spikes loosen over time, leading to the gutters hanging off the home. That can contribute to serious issues if left untreated. Gutters hanging off the home need not necessarily be replaced, but rather secured to the home, ideally with hanger brackets instead of spikes. Brackets hook into the front of the gutter and are then screwed into the fascia of a home. A professional who specializes in gutter repair can perform this task relatively quickly,

signed to hold too much weight. Replacement of separated gutters may or may not be necessary depending on how big the problem is and the condition of the existing gutters. If replacement is not necessary, separated gutters may be remedied by securing the joints, another relatively simple and inexpensive fix.

- Peeling exterior paint: Paint that appears to be peeling off of your home may indicate that water is seeping over the edge of the gutter closest to your home. When that happens, water is coming down the side of the house, causing the paint to peel. In such instances, replacing the gutters is often necessary.
- Basement flooding: Not all signs of deteriorating gutters are outside a home. Many a homeowner has been flummoxed by flooding in their basements, and such flooding can be caused by aging, ineffective gutters. That's because deteriorating gutters sometimes allow water to leak near the foundation of a home, contributing to basement flooding.

Fall is an ideal time to inspect gutters and have any issues fixed before leaves begin to fall or harsh winter weather arrives.

scrutinized and improved so that it can become the major contributor it ought to be, ensuring all Ameri- cans get enough to eat and all farms are supported."

"We are pleased that we have been able to receive additional food through the CFAP program to help us feed the thousands of peo- ple in need during this pan- demic," said Mark Quandt, Director of the Northeast Regional Food Bank. "How- ever, we are also disap- pointed in the implemen- tation of the program. Only one vendor in the entire 23 county region we serve was awarded a contract to dis- tribute food, so we had to reach out to companies in other states and other parts of New York State and hope they would provide food for us. We had some suc- cess, but the process was difficult and cumbersome, and the quality of the boxes varied greatly from vendor to vendor. We hoped the process would improve in round two that began on July 1, but we heard nothing from USDA or vendors until the very end of June and we still have no idea how much food we will be receiving in this round. The program has great potential and I believe it has worked well for some food banks, but it is not liv- ing up to its potential in our area."

**NYSPHSAA Football,
Volleyball,
Competitive Cheer
(Fall) Seasons
Moved to March 1,
2021**

Latham, NY - The New York State Public High School Athletic Association (NYSPHSAA) announced today that football, volley- ball and competitive cheer fall seasons will be post- poned until March 1, 2021 to address membership concerns associated with high-risk fall sports. The de- cision was rendered by the elected NYSPHSAA officers late this afternoon. Low and moderate risk fall sports, meanwhile, are still autho- rized to begin practices on September 21, 2020 as pre- viously announced.

"We've spent two days speaking with nearly 500 athletic directors across the state and it's clear that administering high-risk fall sports during the COVID-19 pandemic presents a sig- nificant challenge for our member schools," said Dr. Robert Zayas, NYSPHSAA Executive Director. "These are unprecedented times and unfortunately, difficult decisions will have to be made to address this ongo- ing crisis. We continue to stay committed to provid- ing support to our member schools and quality partici- pation experiences for the students we serve."

The revised season for football, volleyball and fall competitive cheer will be known as "Fall Sports Season II" and may offi- cially begin practices on March 1, 2021.

As a result of fall high- risk sports being moved, the start date for the spring sports season has been adjusted to April 19, 2021. The first official practice for spring sports will now be

April 19, 2021 (the original start date was March 15).

"The NYSPHSAA officers have determined it would be unrealistic to host foot- ball, volleyball and com- petitive cheer seasons this fall," said Julie Bergman, NYSPHSAA President. "This continues to be the most challenging situation educators have ever ad- dressed. I, along with my fellow officers, believe the participation experiences for football, volleyball and competitive cheer athletes will be more beneficial in the spring than in the fall."

Low and moderate risk fall sports practices are still scheduled to begin on September 21st for those schools and sections who have determined it feasible to host interscholastic ath- letics at this time. Regular season games can begin for low and moderate risk fall sports (girls tennis, cross country, girls swimming/ diving, boys soccer, girls soccer, field hockey) once student-athletes have par- ticipated in the required number of practices as per NYSPHSAA bylaws.

DEC Confirms Epizootic Hemorrhagic Disease in Putnam and Orange County Deer

The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) confirmed that several white-tailed deer in the towns of Nelsonville and Cold Spring in Putnam County and near Goshen in Orange County died after contracting Epizootic Hemorrhagic Disease (EHD). EHD is a viral disease of white-tailed deer that cannot be contracted

by humans.

EHD virus is carried by biting midges, small bugs often called no-see-ums or 'punkies.' Once infected with EHD, deer usually die within 36 hours. The disease is not spread from deer to deer or from deer to humans.

DEC wildlife biologists collected half a dozen deer carcasses in Putnam County and submitted the carcasses to the Wildlife Health Unit for necropsy. Tissue samples were sent to the Animal Health Diagnostic Center at Cornell University where the preliminary diagnosis of EHD

was confirmed. DEC also sent samples from four deer from Orange County where the preliminary diagnosis of EHD was confirmed.

The EHD virus was first confirmed in New York in 2007 in Albany, Rensselaer, and Niagara counties, and in Rockland County in 2011. EHD outbreaks are most common in the late summer and early fall when midges are abundant. EHD symptoms include fever, hemorrhage in muscle or organs, swelling of the head, neck, tongue, and lips. A deer infected with EHD may appear lame or dehydrated. Frequently, infected deer

will seek out water sources and many succumb near a water source. There is no treatment for nor means to prevent EHD. The dead deer do not serve as a source of infection for other animals.

EHD outbreaks do not have a significant long-term impact on deer populations. EHD is endemic in the southern states where there are annual outbreaks, so some southern deer have developed immunity. Generally, in the northeast, EHD outbreaks occur sporadically and deer in New York have no immunity to this virus. Consequently, most EHD-infected deer in

New York are expected to die. In the north, the first hard frost kills the midges that transmit the disease, ending the EHD outbreak.

Hunters should not handle or eat any deer that appears sick or acts strangely. DEC will continue to monitor the situation. Sightings of sick or dying deer should be reported to the nearest DEC Regional Office or to an Environmental Conservation Police Officer. In addition, the Department of Agriculture and Markets has alerted deer farmers and veterinarians throughout the state to be aware of the

CWC Approves Funding For Many Programs

On September 1, the Catskill Watershed Corporation (CWC) Board of Directors approved funding for projects in the Septic Program, Stormwater Retrofit Program, Community Wastewater Management Program, and the Flood Hazard Program.

Funding for the repair or replacement of eight residential septic systems for homeowners in five towns in Delaware, Greene and Ulster Counties was approved. CWC authorized funding for the operation and maintenance costs of a previously completed stormwater retrofit project in Greene County. Additional funding was also approved for two Community Wastewater Management projects in the Town of Shandaken and the hamlet of West Conesville.

In the Flood Hazard Program, funding for five feasibility studies in the Town of Hunter were approved for

two applicants to determine potential flood mitigation options at each property. Design funding was also approved for two projects in the Town of Prattsville to implement recommendations from prior feasibility studies that had been completed. Finally, construction funding was approved for a business in the Village of Walton to fill in an existing crawl space and install a new concrete floor.

Nourish New York Continues to Grow

Nourish New York, Governor Cuomo's initiative to get surplus food from farmers to families in need during the COVID-19 outbreak, reached a milestone in June as the amount of surplus dairy, produce and other products provided through New York's food banks reached over 4.3 million pounds.

Food banks across the state have purchased more than \$4 million in Nourish

NY product from New York's processors and farmers who have temporarily lost markets as a result of COVID-19. This includes 1.7 million pounds of dairy products, including fluid milk, yogurt, cheese, cottage cheese, and sour cream, and more than 2 million pounds of produce, such as fruits and vegetables, that have been provided to more than 140,000 New York households. There have been over 500 Nourish NY food distribution events held across New York to help families in need since the program was launched in May.

In addition, the state also

launched a new Nourish New York web page, found at agriculture.ny.gov/nourishny, to more easily connect food banks with New York's farmers who have product available for purchase. The website allows farmers to submit product type, volume, and other information directly to the page, and allows the food banks to easily search for agricultural products that are in need. Mountains, and Hudson River area,” said Rep. Delgado. “Protecting our planet should be a bipartisan priority and I am glad to see this legislation become law with support on both sides of the aisle. This law will support thousands of jobs maintaining these green spaces and protecting our precious natural landscapes for generations to come.”

The Great American Outdoors Act ensures that the \$900 million permanently authorized by Congress last year funds the Land and

Water Conservation Fund at the levels that were promised. The LWCF is America's most successful conservation program and these resources will make sure that it continues to:

- Support enhanced park and recreational access for local communities throughout the country;
- Address environmental injustice by creating green spaces near low-income communities and communities of color across the country by preserving our natural heritage in an equi-

table manner;

- Strengthens the recreation economy, which is one of the fastest growing economic sectors and a key driver of jobs across the country; and
- Implement recommendations from the Select Committee on the Climate Crisis' Solving the Climate Crisis action plan to support the goal of protecting at least 30 percent of all U.S. lands and ocean areas by 2030 while helping fragile ecosystems, wildlife populations and communi-

ties become more resilient to the impacts of the climate crisis.

The Great American Outdoors Act preserves our National Parks by establishing the National Parks and Public Land Legacy Restoration Fund, which provides federal land management agencies with critical resources to address the \$22 billion deferred maintenance backlog on our public lands.
