DEC Announces Bowhunting Seasons for Deer and Bear

Youth Big Game Hunt Scheduled for Columbus Day Weekend

New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) Commissioner Basil Seggos announced that bowhunting seasons for deer and bear begin in the Northern Zone on Sept. 27, and in the Southern Zone on Oct. 1. Hunters are also reminded to apply for Deer Management Permits by next week's Oct. 1, 2020, deadline.

"New York's skilled bowhunters can find great opportunities for big game in forests and fields throughout the state," Commissioner Seggos said. "With mild weather and longer days, the early bow season is the perfect time to be in the woods and an opportunity to introduce new hunters to deer and bear hunting. Be sure to continue following precautions to keep you and others safe when afield this hunting season."

Deer Management Permit Application Deadline is Oct. 1

The deadline to apply for deer management permits (DMPs/antlerless tags) is fast approaching. Hunters must apply for DMPs by Oct. 1, and should know the Wildlife Management Unit (WMU) they intend to hunt and review their chances of selection before applying. The application fee for DMPs is \$10. The fee is waived for junior hunters and Lifetime License holders who purchased a Lifetime (Sportsman) License prior to Oct. 1, 2009. Hunters who have purchased a hunting license are eligible to apply for up to two DMPs that may be used to harvest antlerless deer from a specified WMU. Antlerless deer harvest is crucial in helping to balance the deer herd with available habitat.

Hunters who still need to purchase their license and permits for the 2020-21 seasons can do so at any one of DEC's 1,200 license issuing outlets, by phone at 1-86-NY-DECALS (866-933-2257), or online through our DECALS website.

Youth Big Game Hunt

New York's annual Youth Big Game Hunt is scheduled for Columbus Day weekend, Oct. 10-12. During this special opportunity, licensed 14- and 15-year-olds may use a firearm to hunt big game while accompanied by an experienced, licensed adult hunter. All eligible junior hunters may take one deer (either sex) and one bear. During the youth hunt, antlerless deer taken with a firearm may be tagged with a regular season tag, DMP, or Deer Management Assistance Program tag. Antlered deer may only be tagged with the regular season tag. Though junior hunters may have multiple deer tags, they may only take one deer with a firearm during the Youth Big Game Hunt.

The Youth Big Game Hunt takes place throughout the state, except in Suffolk County and in bowhunting-only areas. Additional rules that apply to junior hunters and their adult mentors are noted on pages 36 and 37 of the Hunting & Trapping Guide or through the Junior Hunter Mentoring Program.

DEC reminds hunters of the importance of reporting their harvest. Harvest reporting is critical to wildlife management, and hunters are required by law to report their harvest of deer, bear, and turkey within seven days of taking the animal. You can report your harvest online through our DECALS website or by phone at 866-426-3778. You may also report via DEC's HuntFishNY mobile app. Through this mobile app, hunters, anglers, and trappers can access an electronic version of their licenses and privileges, and report the harvest of deer, bear, and turkey im-

mediately while afield on their mobile device. New users of the HuntFishNY App need to download the newest version and use the new login created through the new DECALS licensing system. While hunters may still use the phone report system, the online and mobile systems are faster, more convenient, and easier for hunters to accurately enter information.



- When hunting any type of deer, elk, moose, or caribou outside of New York, debone the harvested animal before bringing it back to the state. See CWD Regulations for Hunters. DEC will confiscate and destroy illegally imported carcasses and parts;
- Do not use deer urine-based lures or attractant scents;
- Dispose of carcass waste in a landfill, not on the landscape;
- Report any deer that appears sick or acting abnormally; and

DEC also encourages all hunters to wear blaze orange or blaze pink to make themselves more visible to other hunters. Hunters who wear blaze orange are seven times less likely to be shot. When hunting in tree stands, use a full-body harness and lifeline. Most tree stand accidents occur when hunters are climbing in and out of the stand, so use a harness and lifeline to stay connected from the time you leave the ground to the time you get back down.

VID-19 antibodies may now help current coronavirus patients in need of convalescent plasma transfusions. Donors are encouraged to make an appointment to give blood now to help ensure coronavirus patients and others who depend on transfusions have needed blood products this fall.

In April, the Red Cross began collecting COVID-19 convalescent plasma from previously diagnosed individuals, who could only give at one of approximately 170 Red Cross blood donation centers across the country. Convalescent plasma con-

tains COVID-19 antibodies that may help the most critical patients actively fighting this virus. Now, whole blood donations made at any Red Cross blood drive or blood donation center could be helpful in this effort.

The Red Cross encourages eligible individuals to schedule an appointment, download the free Blood Donor App, visit RedCrossBlood.org, call 1-800-RED CROSS (1-800-733-2767) or enable the Blood Donor Skill on any Alexa Echo device.

Antibody testing may indicate if the donor's immune system has produced antibodies to this coronavirus, regardless of whether an individual experienced COVID-19 symptoms. Donations are tested using samples pulled at the time of donation and sent to a testing laboratory where they will also undergo routine infectious disease testing.

COVID-19 antibody test results will be available within one to two weeks in the Red Cross Blood Donor App or donor portal at RedCrossBlood.org. A positive antibody test result does not confirm infection or immunity. The Red Cross is not testing donors to diagnose illness, referred to as a diagnostic test.

Each Red Cross blood drive and donation center follows the highest standards of safety and infection control, and additional precautions - including temperature checks, social distancing and face coverings for donors and staff - have been implemented to help protect the health of all those in attendance. Donors are asked to schedule an appointment prior to arriving at the drive and are required to wear a face covering or mask while at the drive, in alignment with Centers for Disease Control and Prevention public guidance.



DEC Proposes a Holiday Deer Hunt

DEC is proposing an additional bowhunting and muzzleloader hunting opportunity in the Southern Zone between Christmas and New Year's Day. The new season would add seven days of late-season hunting from Dec. 26 through Jan. 1, providing time for families to hunt together while students are on school break.

The additional hunting season is proposed only for the Southern Zone because deer in the Northern Zone may already be moving to winter concentration areas by Christmas. Hunting seasons that occur when deer are migrating or are already concentrated in wintering areas could result in localized overharvest.

Initial discussions of this proposal created some confusion about potential impacts on snowmobiling. DEC and the NYS Office

of Parks, Recreation, and Historic Preservation have clarified that snowmobile trails are opened after the end of the regular big game hunting season, subject to adequate snow cover and local agreements. Thus, the proposed additional hunting opportunity would not affect the opening of snowmobile trails. Details of the proposal are published in the September 9 issue of the NYS Register. 

ing musician in her father's Midnight Ramble Band. On This Too Shall Light, Helm says that two songs in particular pay homage to Levon — "The Stones I Throw," a song he released in 1965 with Levon and the Hawks, and the closing traditional number, an a cappella version of the hymnal "Gloriyland," which was passed from father to daughter.

DEC Environmental Conservation Police Officer Highlights Recent ECO Actions

New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) Environmental Conservation Police Officers (ECOs) enforce the 71 Chapters of NY Environmental Conservation Law (ECL), protecting fish and wildlife and preserving environmental quality across New York.

In 2019, the 288 ECOs across the state responded to 25,704 calls and worked on cases that resulted in 16,855 tickets or arrests for crimes ranging from deer poaching to solid waste dumping, illegal mining, the black market pet trade, and excessive emissions violations.

This year marks 50 years for DEC and 140 Years for New York's Conservation Police Officers. In 1880, the first eight Game Protectors proudly began serving to protect the natural resources and people of New York State.

"From Montauk Point and Brooklyn to Buffalo, the ECOs patrolling our state are the first line of defense in protecting New York's environment and our natural resources, ensuring that they exist for future generations of New Yorkers," said DEC Commissioner Basil Seggos. "Our ECOs have worked arduous hours, both deep in our remote wildernesses and in the tight confines of our urban landscapes, for far longer than the 50 years since DEC was created. These officers are critical to achieving DEC's mission to protect and enhance our environment and I am confident they will continue this important mission for the next 50 years and beyond."

On Sept. 13, ECO Osborne received a complaint from a farmer who witnessed a man shoot from his vehicle in the town of Deposit the previous evening. The complainant obtained the shooter's license plate and ECO Osborne ran the plate and responded to interview different subjects. After separating the parties involved, ECO Osborne compiled a Sept. 12 timeline of events for the four subjects. The subjects admitted to driving around the town of Deposit in search of small game, shooting various critters from both a public highway and a motor vehicle. The subjects ended up shooting at beavers and fish, and killed an assortment of wildlife ranging from squirrels, chipmunks, songbirds, and hawks. As the day went on, the subjects shot at three different deer from a motor vehicle on a public highway with bird shot. ECO Osborne issued the subjects tickets for a total of 35 different charges ranging

from hunting with the aid of a motor vehicle, hunting from a public roadway, killing protected birds, hunting without a license, trespassing, attempting to take big game illegally, hunting out of season, and allowing a junior hunter to hunt both big and small game without an adult mentor. The subjects, all under the age of 18, were arraigned in the Town of Deposit Court on Sept. 14 and paid a civil penalty of \$1,300.

Prattsville Clews - A Case Study Online Exhibit

The Zadock Pratt Museum in collaboration with Prattsville Art Center presents Prattsville Clews - A Case Study by Clover Archer, an online exhibition exploring micro or granular histories - small ordinary moments in everyday lives that fill in the vast amount of time around lifetime milestones or what is more generally considered "important."

As a creative endeavor that combines contemporary artistic practice with historical research, the Prattsville Clews Project online exhibition is a collaboration between the Zadock Pratt Museum and the Prattsville Art Center. This project brings together the missions of Prattsville's historical foundation and its creative community center to examine overlooked trajectories between the past, present, and future, and to celebrate this unique area of the Catskill region.

In Part I of this two-part presentation, the Zadock Pratt Museum is hosting a digital exhibition of the graphite drawings, the text of the "clews" that inspired the drawings, and the family trees that became artworks as their branches were jointly filled in by current family members with names and stories. In Part II of this two-part presentation, the Prattsville Art Center will host on its website the Clew Registry wherein visitors are invited to contribute a biographical detail that may subtly shift how future researchers will understand them. Through the online form, registrants are invited to submit a fact, memory, habit, characteristic that we could not know from internet research, that is not part of the public record, and that would otherwise be lost to time. A Clew can be as simple as "I like to chew ice" or "I rub my feet together when I'm sleepy," or as complex as an intimate childhood memory or recurring dream. Newly registered Clews will be added to the website over the course of the digital exhibition.

In the summer of 2019, as an artist in residence at the Prattsville Art Center, Clover Archer worked closely with the Zadock Pratt Museum to learn more about the history of the area. During this

time, she met with Prattsville citizens who generously shared their family histories, stories, photographs, and memorabilia.

While meeting with local residents, the artist made notations on large family tree charts documenting their stories as the Prattsvillian contributors reminisced. The artist calls these small human histories "clews."

Our contemporary word "clue" is derived from the word "clew," originally meaning a ball of yarn or thread. In one Greek myth a "clew" or ball of yarn is used to lead the way out of a labyrinth, which is how we have come to understand the word to mean something that leads to a solution or an answer. Thinking of the labyrinth as a metaphor for life, the artist considers these granular histories to be the moments that lead us through the maze of our existence - guiding the way and filling the time between the more memorable and more commonly documented occasions.

Based on this information, the artist has created a series of graphite drawings illustrating a small sampling of the clews that are connected to Prattsville. These small details are both particular to Prattsville and yet not geographically specific. Looking at these illustrations of the ordinary (i.e., a broom, a sled, a car, a cow, etc.), we all have associations with them - we see them as familiar and share the humanity of the small particulars. "Kenneth Wilson Campground is set in the heart of the Catskills and with recently completed improvements, will offer an enhanced experience for

everyone who wants to enjoy New York's great outdoors," Commissioner Seggos said. "DEC is investing in facilities statewide to both improve the environmental and ensure it's more accessible and welcoming to visitors with diverse backgrounds and abilities."

Kenneth L. Wilson Campground in Mount Tremper offers secluded, wooded campsites and many outdoor activities. Campers can enjoy a hike on the nature trails or ride on the mountain bike trail (for advanced riders), and nearby villages offer numerous shops and restaurants. The campground features great amenities including boating, fishing, and hiking and recently was recognized in the first-annual Hudson Valley Chronogram Readers' Choice Awards under the Nature and the Outdoors category, along with the first-place campground at DEC's North-South Lake.

Accessible Comfort Stations and Shower House Renovations


DEC invested \$476,000 through NY Works to design and construct significant infrastructure improvements to campground's shower house and three comfort stations. Many of the improvements will help decrease the campground's overall environmental footprint by reducing water and energy consumption. Highlights of the improvements include:

- Energy efficient, on-demand hot water systems;
- Energy efficient LED lighting;
- New accessible tile floors;
- Energy efficient windows and doors;
- Accessible fixtures including water saving showers, sinks, and toilets;
- New accessible showers and stalls;
- New accessible toilet stalls;
- Painting, new mirrors, and other hardware;
- Accessibility improvements to Caretaker Cabin; and
- Accessibility and paving improvements throughout campground.

DEC recently recognized the 30th Anniversary of the Americans with Disabilities Act and upgrades like those announced today demonstrate New York State's commitment to helping people with disabilities fully participate in and enjoy the benefits of DEC's facilities, services, programs, and activities. The facility's improvements allow visitors, including seniors and families with small children, to access its amenities consistent with the Governor's 2018 Executive Order to make New York the first age-friendly state in the country.
