



USDA Reminds Dairy Producers of Dec. 11 Deadline for 2021 Safety-Net **Enrollment**

The U.S. Department of Agriculture reminds dairy producers that the deadline to enroll in Dairy Margin Coverage (DMC) for calendar year 2021 is Friday, Dec. 11, 2020. US-DA's Farm Service Agency (FSA) opened DMC signup in October to help producers manage economic risk brought on by milk price

and feed cost disparities. "2020 has been a challenging year for agricultural producers, and we don't know vet what the next year will bring," FSA Administrator Richard Fordyce. "Dairy producers should definitely consider coverage for 2021 as even the slightest drop in the margin can trigger

payments." The DMC program, created by the 2018 Farm Bill, offers reasonably priced

protection to dairy producers when the difference between the all-milk price and the average feed cost (the margin) falls below a certain dollar amount selected by the producer.

Complete 2021 Enrollment/Evaluate Coverage Options

For DMC enrollment, producers must certify with FSA that the operation is commercially marketing milk, sign all required forms, and pay the \$100 administrative fee unless the dairy operation qualifies for a limited resource, beginning, socially disadvantaged, or military veteran farmers and ranchers waiver.

Producers interested in DMC have the option to select a \$4.00 catastrophic level of coverage with no premium fee or they can choose to buy-up coverage where the premium is based on margin triggers between \$4.50 and \$9.50 on 5 to 95 percent of estab-

lished production history. To determine the appropriate level of DMC coverage for a specific dairy operation, producers can utilize the recently updated online dairy decision tool. The decision tool is designed to demonstrate the historical performance

EGGNOG THUMBPRINTS

3/4 cup butter, softened

½ cup sugar

1/8 teaspoon ground nutmeg

2 egg yolks

1 teaspoon vanilla

1 ½ cups all-purpose flour

2 slightly beaten egg whites

1 cup finely chopped walnuts

1 recipe Rum Filling (see below)

Ground nutmeg

1. In a large mixing bowl beat butter with an electric mixer on medium to high speed for 30 seconds. Add sugar and the ½ teaspoon nutmeg. Beat until combined, scraping sides of bowl occasionally. Beat in egg yolks and vanilla

until combined. Beat in as much of the flour as you can with the mixer. Stir in any remaining flour with a wooden spoon. Cover and chill dough about 1 hour or until easy to handle.

- 2. Lightly grease a cookie sheet; set aside. Shape dough into 1-inch balls. Roll balls in egg whites; roll in shopped walnuts to coat. Place balls about 1 inch apart on prepared cookie sheet. Press your thumb into the center of each ball.
- 3. Bake in a 375° oven for 10 to 12 minutes or until edges are lightly browned. Transfer cookies to a wire rack and let cool. Just before serving, pipe or spoon about ½ teaspoon Rum Filling into the center of each cookie. Sprinkle with additional nutmeg.

Rum Filling: In a small bowl, beat 1/4 cup softened butter for 30 seconds. Beat in 1 cup sifted pow-



dered sugar until fluffy. Beat in 1 teaspoon rum or ½ teaspoon rum extract and enough milk (1 to 2 tablespoons) to make it spreading consistency. Vicky Klukkert



- 16 oz. can unsweet pineapple chunks
- 2 teaspoons lemon juice
- 2 teaspoons cornstarch
- 2 teaspoons sugar replacement
- 1 teaspoon margarin
- 1 apple (chopped)
- 1 banana (sliced)

Drain juice from apricots and pineapple into saucepan. Add lemon and cornstarch. Cook over low heat to thicken. Remove from heat. Add sugar replacement and margarin. Stir to blend. Cool slightly. Combine all fruit in bowl, pour sauce over fruit.

8 oz. white baking bars or white chocolate baking squares

½ cup butter, softened

1 cup sugar

1 teaspoon baking soda

1/4 teaspoon salt

2 eggs

2 ¾ cups all-purpose flour

½ cup seedless raspberry jam

3 ounces white baking bars or white chocolate baking squares

1/2 teaspoon shortening

1. Grease a large cookie sheet; set aside. Chop 4 ounces of the white baking bars; set aside. In a small heavy saucepan melt 4 ounces baking bars over low heat, stir-

ring constantly; cool

2. In a large mixing bowl, beat butter with an electric mixer on medium to high speed for 30 seconds. Add sugar, baking soda and salt. Beat until combined, scraping sides of bowl occasionally. Beat in eggs and melted baking bars until combined. Beat in as much of the flour as you can with the mixer. Sir in any remaining flur with a wooden

spoon. Sir in the 4 ounces chopped baking bars (dough will be stiff).

3. Drop dough from rounded teaspoons 2 inches apart onto the prepared cookie sheet. Bake at 375° for 7 to 9 minutes or until edges are lightly browned. Cool on cookie sheet for 1 minute. Transfer cookies to a wire rack and let cool.

OATMEAL CRAISIN COOKIES

1 cup butter (2 sticks)

 cup firm packed brown sugar

½ cup granulated sugar

- 2 eggs
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 1 ½ cups flour
- 1 teaspoon baking soda

1 teaspoon cinnamon

½ teaspoon salt

3 cups oats (quick or old fashioned uncooked)

1 cup craisins

Preheat oven to 350°.

Beat butter and sugars until creamy. Add eggs and vanilla, beat well. Add combined flour, baking soda, cinnamon and salt. Add oatmeal and craisins, mix well.

Drop by rounded tablespoons on ungreased cookie sheet. Bake 10-12 minutes or until golden brown.

Cool 1 minute on cookie sheet, remove to wire rack.

Makes about 4 dozen.

Bar cookies: press dough onto bottom of uncreased 13" x 9" metal baking pan. Bake 30-35 minutes.

1 teas. Salt

1 teas. Vanilla

1 cup dk. Brown sugar

4 teas. Ground cinnamon

5 teas. Ground ginger

2 teas. Ground nutmeg

2 teas. Ground cloves

18 TB. Unsalted butter (softened but not melted)

1 1/4 cup molasses

2 eggs

6 cups flour

1 tsp baking powder

1. In a large bowl or stand up mixer, beat the butter, molasses, brown sugar, vanilla and eggs until

2. Combine the dry ingredients and flour in a separate bowl. Slowly add one cup of dry ingredients to the wet ingredients in the mixer or large bowl at a time.

Leave ½ cup of flour out for rolling dough later.

- 3. Separate dough into 3 flattened balls. Wrap them in plastic wrap and leave in refrigerator overnight to chill.
 - 4. Preheat oven to 375 degrees
- 5. Line two cookie sheets with parchment paper
- 6. Sprinkle left over flour onto a clean, flat surface to roll cookie dough. Roll dough to 1/4" thickness
- 7. Begin cutting cookies and place onto baking sheets. Leave

at least 1" space between each cookie


- 8. Bake medium sized gingerbread cookies for 8-10 minutes and larger sized cookies for 12-15 minutes
