"Secrets of Kelly Hollow" Revealed on History Hike

Renowned forest historian Dr. Michael Kudish will lead a hike on State trails at Kelly Hollow in the Millbrook valley Saturday, May 15 to reconstruct his search for a massive though short-lived sawmill and railroad.

"Secrets of Kelly Hollow," sponsored by the Historical Society of the Town of Middletown, will feature a 3.5 to 4-mile hike to the site of the industrial operation, as well as to the remnants of five 19th century homesteads.

HSM president Diane Galusha will be along to share the tragic and unusual stories of the families, several of them immigrants, who occupied those hardscrabble farms. They were the Gavetts, Wards, Newtons, Andrews and of course the Kellys whose abandoned farm became the base of operations for the lumber and sawmill enterprise.

James Owen purchased the timber on the abandoned Kelly farm in 1907. In 1908, he constructed a forest railroad to bring the logs nearly a mile over rough terrain to be sawn into lumber and hauled to Arena, perhaps to be shipped to market on the new Delaware & Eastern Railroad. Dr. Kudish made 12 visits to the Hollow to locate the route of the timber train, which "sped around curves and over trestles" according to the Catskill Mountain News Oct. 23, 1908.

The News predicted it would be 'a perfect success,' but the timber was depleted by 1909 and the mill and railroad were dismantled. In the intervening 110 years, the forest has all but consumed every trace of human use and occupation at Kelly Hollow.

mate change. According to a study conducted by Audubon Society, climate change currently threatens 389 bird species in North America - two-thirds of all the species on the continent. Locally, even common species such as Canada Goose, American Woodcock, and American Goldfinch are vulnerable to habitat loss from climate change. The grants provided by the Community Climate Action program will fund projects that protect birds and their habitats against climate change on a local level.

Applicants are encouraged to think locally about the habitats, species, and communities in Delaware-Otsego Audubon Society's region that may be lost or threatened by climate change. Proposed projects can address climate change in a variety of ways - through environmental stewardship and preservation, building native plant bird habitats, engaging in sustainable or carbon re-

ducing practices such as waste reduction, or composting, providing public education or communications with elected officials.

Projects must take place within the Delaware-Otsego Audubon Society's chapter region, which includes northern Delaware County, Otsego County, eastern Chenango County, and western Schoharie County, as well as small regions in southern Herkimer and Montgomery Counties.

Project proposals are due by 5 p.m. on Friday, May 14 2021. Informational sessions will be provided via Zoom on April 8 and 29 at 7 p.m. Pre-registration is required (registration links are in the application document). Delaware-Otsego Audubon Society looks forward to receiving proposals from throughout our region which will impact our local environment and wildlife. Recipients of funding will be announced on May 28, 2021.

CWC Appoints a New Executive Director

On March 2, the Catskill Watershed Corporation (CWC) Board of Directors appointed Jason Merwin as the new Executive Director. Mr. Merwin will replace long time CWC Executive Director, Alan Rosa as he nears his retirement from the organization after over two and a half decades of service. Mr. Merwin has been an employee of CWC for nine years and has been acting as Assistant Executive Director for the previous three years. Mr. Merwin is a 2004 graduate of Gilboa-Conesville Central School and has a Bachelor's degree in Political Science from the University of Central Florida and a Master's degree in Public Administration from Marist College.

Outgoing Executive Director, Alan Rosa held the post since 1998. Prior to this Mr. Rosa was the first President of the CWC Board of Directors and was intimately involved with the creation of the corporation. Alan has been a passionate and dedicated advocate for the watershed communities since the early 1990's. While serving as the elected Supervisor of the Town of Middletown, Delaware County, Alan was the lead negotiator for the local watershed communities and

the Coalition of Watershed Towns for over five years of discussions with the City of New York, State of New York, Environmental Protection Agency, and various environmental groups. Those negotiations resulted in the landmark 1997 Watershed Memorandum of Agreement which continues to serve as the basis of all of the Watershed Programs benefiting the local communities. Alan's perspective, insight, and quiet leadership guided CWC and the watershed communities through numerous successes including opening of City land for recreation and hunting, supporting local businesses with grants immediately following Hurricane Irene, as well as continuation of all CWC Programs.

In other action, the CWC Board of Directors also awarded funding for replacement septic systems and additional construction costs to a total of 13 homeowners in eight towns in Delaware, Greene, and Ulster Counties.

Funding from the Flood Hazard Mitigation Program was approved for construction costs to complete the construction of recommended flood mitigation measures for a homeowner in the Town of

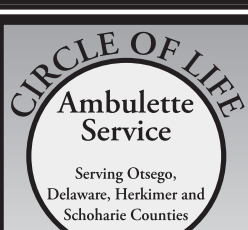

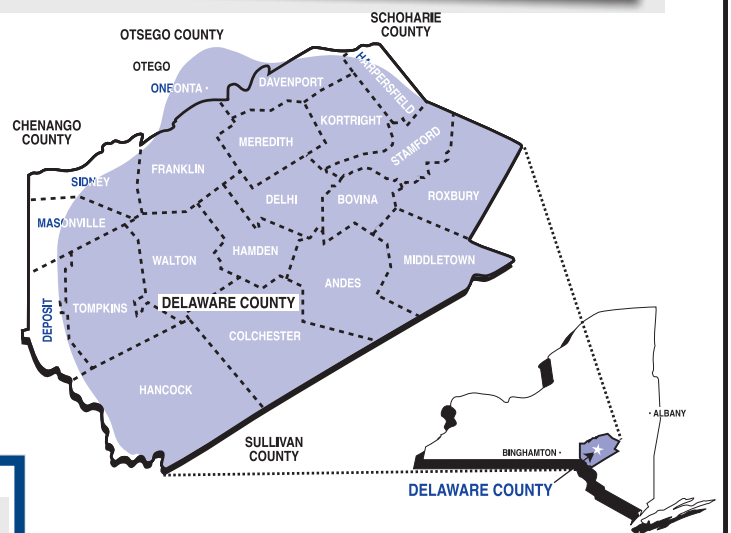

and purple, offbeat beets, arugula, and the heritage varieties of cucumber that once graced Victory Gardens. This year, there will be some flowers to feed the bees.

Wherever possible, TC buy organic seeds to avoid the systemic neonicotinoids that kill off our native pollinators, and to discourage the use of other pesticides on seed farms. If you have leftover seeds, consider bringing them to the library to share with your fellow gardeners.

Some libraries have reduced hours due to Covid restrictions, so be sure to check the website or phone the librarian to discover when you may safely drop by.

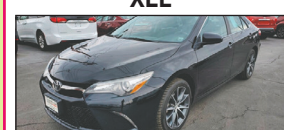
