

"Secrets of Kelly **Hollow**" Revealed on History Hike

Renowned forest historian Dr. Michael Kudish will lead a hike on State trails at Kelly Hollow in the Millbrook valley Saturday, May 15 to reconstruct his search for a massive though short-lived sawmill and railroad.

"Secrets of Kelly Hollow," sponsored by the Historical Society of the Town of Middletown, will feature a 3.5 to 4-mile hike to the site of the industrial operation, as well as to the remnants of five 19th century homesteads.

HSM president Diane Galusha will be along to share the tragic and unusual stories of the families, several of them immigrants, who occupied those hardscrabble farms. They were the Gavetts, Wards, Newtons, Andrews and of course the Kellys whose abandoned farm became the base of operations for the lumber and sawmill enterprise.

James Owen purchased the timber on the abandoned Kelly farm in 1907. In 1908, he constructed a forest railroad to bring the logs nearly a mile over rough terrain to be sawn into lumber and hauled to Arena, perhaps to be shipped to market on the new Delaware & Eastern Railroad. Dr. Kudish made 12 visits to the Hollow to locate the route of the timber train, which "sped around curves and over trestles" according to the Catskill Mountain News Oct. 23, 1908.

The News predicted it would be 'a perfect success,' but the timber was depleted by 1909 and the mill and railroad were dismantled. In the intervening 110 years, the forest has all but consumed every trace of human use and occupation at Kelly Hollow.



mate change. According to a study conducted by Audubon Society, climate change currently threatens 389 bird species in North America - two-thirds of all the species on the continent. Locally, even common species such as Canada Goose, American Woodcock, and American Goldfinch are vulnerable to habitat loss from climate change. The grants provided by the Community Climate Action program will fund projects that protect birds and their habitats against climate change on a local level.

Applicants are encouraged to think locally about the habitats, species, and communities in Delaware-Otsego Audubon Society's region that may be lost or threatened by climate change. Proposed projects can address climate change in a variety of ways - through environmental stewardship and preservation, building native plant bird habitats, engaging in sustainable or carbon re-





Harpersfield Historical Society Receives Grant for Historical Markers

The Harpersfield Historical Society has received a grant from the Delaware County Economic Development Office for the placement of 10 historic markers commemorating the Sugar Bush Raid of 1780.

During the dark days of 1780 in our area, local families were at the point of starvation while at the same time, being constantly threatened by raids from Loyalists and their Native American allies, under the leadership of Mohawk captain Joseph Brant.

On April 7th of that year, a group of 15 men were on a scout in Harpersfield, looking for signs of the enemy while also taking time to make maple sugar to bring to the Patriot refugees back at the Schoharie Valley forts. As the men worked at several sugar bush camps, they were surprised by Brant's men. William Stevens and two Hendry brothers were killed outright, others were wounded and captured, including Captain Alexander Harper, one of the early founders of Harpersfield. Among those captured were Cornelius Teabout, a Black resident from the Middleburgh area, Freegift and Isaac Patchin, and young William Lamb, age 12, who was with his father at the time.

"The Sugar Bush Raid was a critical event in our region during the American Revolution," according to Tom Kendall, President of the Harpersfield Historical Society. "I am a descendant of the Patchin family,

Some of the signs will also tell about the Loyalist and Native participation in the raid. During the war, as Patriot families fled their homes, Harpersfield became a hotbed of Loyalist activity. Often, raiders fought against their own family members, and even Capt. Harper's own cousin, captured at Cobleskill, was married to a British officer at Fort Niagara. Her influence helped save his life.

The \$5,000 grant from the Delaware County Economic Development Office. The Delaware County Occupancy Tax was enacted into law by the Board of Supervisors for the purposes of creating a dedicated funding stream to promote and develop the tourism industry within Delaware County and stimulating economic growth. Funds raised through the occupancy tax support the implementation of programs designed to promote and increase tourism in Delaware County, as well as projects relating to capital and infrastructure investments supporting the further development of this vital industry. For example, heritage tourism generates more revenue than a typical day-tripper.

One of the sites to be commemorated is where Ezra Thorp and the two Patchin brothers were captured. A large rock overlooks the place and was visited by family members who remembered the sufferings that the war brought on.

"Upon the top of the rock, eight or ten feet from the face, a stake was formerly kept to mark the exact spot. Mr. Ezra T. Patchin states that when a small boy he often visited the place with Ezra Thorp, and with his grandmother, the widow of Isaac Patchin, and has often seen Mr. Thorp shed tears when recalling his suffer-

ings while in captivity," from The History of Delaware County, 1797-1880 by W.W. Munsell.

The grant has a dollarfor-dollar matching fund requirement, and the Society needs the support of residents and businesses to fulfill the goal of the 10 historic markers. In addition, maps and brochures about the raid and the historic marker program will be available for schools and local businesses. The Harpersfield Historical Society requests the support of area residents and businesses to make the historic marker program a reality. Those who contribute will be acknowledged and specially invited at the dedication of the markers as they are placed throughout Harpersfield.

DEC Announces New Opportunity for Youth Hunters

New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) Commissioner Basil Seggos announced a new opportunity for young hunters. The State Fiscal Year 2021-22 Budget signed by Governor Andrew M. Cuomo includes legislation that now allows youths ages 12 and 13 to hunt deer with a firearm or crossbow under the supervision of an experienced adult hunter in upstate counties that opt-in to participate.

"Deer hunting is a valued tradition for many families that provides millions of pounds of quality food to New Yorkers while reducing the negative impacts of abundant deer populations on agriculture, forests, and communities," Commissioner Seggos said. "This new hunting to the next generation. Teaching these young people safe, responsible, and ethical hunting practices will ensure a rewarding experience every time they are afield. I encourage all upstate counties to consider 'opting-in' to support New York's young hunters and their potential contributions to deer management."

For nearly two decades, youth aged 12 and 13 in New York have been safely hunting deer and bear with archery equipment and small game with firearms. Until now, New York was the only state that didn't allow 12- and 13-year-olds to hunt big game with a firearm. Environmental Conservation Law 11-0935 is a temporary measure that will pilot lowering the age through 2023, including the following provisions:

• Allows 12- and 13-yearold licensed hunters to hunt deer with a rifle, shotgun, or muzzleloading firearm in areas these firearms may be used during hunting season;

• Allows 12- and 13-yearold licensed hunters to hunt deer with a crossbow during the times when other hunters may use crossbows;

• Requires that these youth hunters be supervised by experienced and licensed adult hunters at all times; and

• Requires the youth hunter and adult mentor to wear fluorescent orange or pink clothing and to remain at ground level while hunting deer with a crossbow, rifle, shotgun, or muzzleloader.

The legislation requires each county to "opt-in" to the program by adopting a local law allowing for 12and 13-year-olds to hunt deer in accordance with ECL 11-0935. The legislation specifically excludes Bronx, Kings, Nassau, New York, Queens, Richmond, Suffolk, and Westchester counties from participation in the new program.
