



Rep. Delgado: American Rescue Plan Relief for Restaurants Available

Today, U.S. Representative Antonio Delgado (NY-19) announced May 3 that restaurants, food trucks, bars, bakeries, breweries, wineries, and other entities in upstate New York will be able to apply for direct relief through the Restaurant Revitalization Fund beginning TODAY, May 3, at 12:00 p.m. ET. The \$28.6 billion Restaurant Revitalization Fund was created by the American Rescue Plan that Rep. Delgado helped pass last month. The law incorporated key provisions from the RESTAURANTS Act, which Rep. Delgado also co-sponsored in the previous Congress.

"Upstate New York's independent restaurants are cornerstones of our community, where we gather with friends and family and mark special occasions in our lives," said Rep. Delgado. "I'm proud that we passed direct relief for our small businesses and the people they employ as part of the American Rescue Plan. The comeback of our restaurant and hospitality businesses is an important key to a full recovery."

The Restaurant Revitalization Fund will provide restaurants and other eligible businesses with funding equal to their pandemic-related revenue loss. This program provides restaurants with funding equal to pandemic-related revenue losses up to \$5 million per location and up to \$10 million per business. The relief does not have to be repaid, provided that the funds are put toward eligible uses by March 11, 2023. These funds can be used for payroll costs, rent, utilities, business supplies, and many more expenses.

tion portal will remain open to any eligible businesses until all funds are exhausted. Participating POS providers include Square, Toast, Clover, NCR Corporation (Aloha). Entities that work with Square or Toast, you do not need to register beforehand on the portal.

- Caterers
- Bars, saloons, lounges, taverns
- Snack and nonalcoholic beverage bars
- Bakeries (onsite sales to the public comprise at least 33% of gross receipts)
- Brewpubs, tasting rooms, taprooms (onsite sales to the public comprise at least 33% of gross receipts)
- Breweries and/or microbreweries (onsite sales to the public comprise at least 33% of gross receipts)
- Wineries and distilleries (onsite sales to the public comprise at least 33% of gross receipts)
- Inns (onsite sales of food and beverage to the public comprise at least 33% of gross receipts)
- Licensed facilities or premises of a beverage alcohol producer where the public may taste, sample, or purchase products.

Rep. Delgado Helps Secure Over \$6.8 Million Investment in Local Head Start Programs

U.S. Representative Antonio Delgado (NY-19) announced a federal investment of more than \$6.8 million for Head Start and Early Head Start Programs in New York's 19th Congressional District. The investment will support early education and development services in Dutchess, Ulster, and Schoharie counties.

"I am proud to announce an over \$6.8 million investment in NY-19 Head Start programs," said Rep. Delgado. "As a father, I know how important childcare and early education access are in upstate. Head Start gives every child the opportunity to access quality education and sets millions of our youngest up for success. Head Start programs are essential, and I will keep working to secure additional funding for our children and communities."

Head Start and Early Head Start programs provide comprehensive child development programs for children from birth to age five, pregnant women, and families. The programs focus on preparing children for school. On December 21, 2020, Rep. Delgado voted to pass H.R. 133, the Consolidated Appropriations Act, which included \$10.7 billion in federal funding for Head Start, an increase of \$135 million.

Churchill Park Walking Tour in Stamford

The Harpersfield Historical Society will host a walking tour of the Churchill Park Historic District in Stamford on Sunday, May 9, beginning at 2 p.m.

Participants will meet at the former site of the Rexmere Hotel for the two-hour walk that is wheelchair and stroller accessible.

The Victorian homes and landscaped grounds of Churchill Park, Stamford, will be highlighted during a walking tour of the historic district on Mother's Day. Once home to the magnificent Rexmere Hotel, which was lost to fire in 2014, Churchill Park retains the charm and history of Dr. Churchill's vision for a planned community, when Stamford established its reputation as Queen

of the Catskills. Home to more than 50 cottages and former summer boarding homes, Churchill Park is filled with Late Victorian and early 20th-century architectural gems.

The Colonial Cottage, once the residence of Dr. Churchill, stands next to the site of the Rexmere hotel, and across the street is the Atchinson House. Other cottages designed and built by Dr. Churchill include Lochmere, Elsmere, Windermere and the Honeymoon Cottage, bordering Lake Rexmere. Additional homes include the Mondore Cottage, built by Jay Mondore, local mason in the late 1800s and the Fisher Cottage built in 1917.

Churchill Park Historic District was listed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1980 and covers much of the western portion of Stamford village, town of Harpersfield. It extends along West Main Street and Lake Street, West End Avenue and Harper Street. Other noted buildings in the district include Greystone Lodge and now-vacant former grand hotels like the Madison and Westholm.

Following the tour, there is a special exhibit on the historic hotels and cottages at the Harpersfield Historical Society Museum from 4 to 5 p.m. The museum is at 795 Colonel Harper Drive, next to the post office.




