## DID YOU KNOW?

July 4th is a day when Americans celebrate their independence, but it's also a day to commemorate two men who played vital roles in procuring that independence. Both John Adams, the second President of the United States, and his successor Thomas Jefferson passed away on July 4, 1826. The two men had an interesting relationship that became increasingly complex as the nation they helped to found developed. According to History.com, Adams and Jefferson were confidantes in the 1780s. But as time wore on, each man developed a different view of what the United States government should be, creating a rift in their relationship that was only widened by the 1800 presidential election. The men ran against each other in that election, which is still considered one of the more contentious elections in American history. Jefferson ultimately claimed victory, a result so unnerving to Adams that he left Washington, D.C. prior to Jefferson's inauguration. The two men would ultimately reconcile, exchanging more than 150 letters before dying within hours of one another on Independence Day in 1826.

# INDEPENDENCE DAY

## WHY IS INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATED ON JULY 4TH?

The Continental Congress declared its independence from Great Britain on July 2, 1776. If that date raises an eyebrow, it should. Independence Day in the United States has long been celebrated on July 4th, which would seem to be two days late. But upon closer examination, it seems Americans are not really celebrating their independence two days later than they should be. According to the National Constitution Center, the Continental Congress approved a resolution declaring its independence from



Great Britain on July 2. However, a document still needed to be drafted to explain the decision to the general public. Such a document was already in the works, but it took two days for the men of Congress to agree on a final version. The resulting document, known as the Declaration of Independence, was sent to John Dunlap,

an Irish printer who served under George Washington during the American Revolutionary War, who subsequently printed roughly 200 broadsides. Still, the Declaration of Independence was not read to the public until July 8, 1776, when Colonel John Nixon did so in Philadelphia on what is now known as Independence Square. It was nearly a month later, on August 2, 1776, when most members of the Continental Congress actually signed the Declaration of Independence in Philadelphia.

## TIPS FOR HOSTING A FUN 4TH OF JULY PARTY

looking for something beyond the norm won't be disappointed, either.

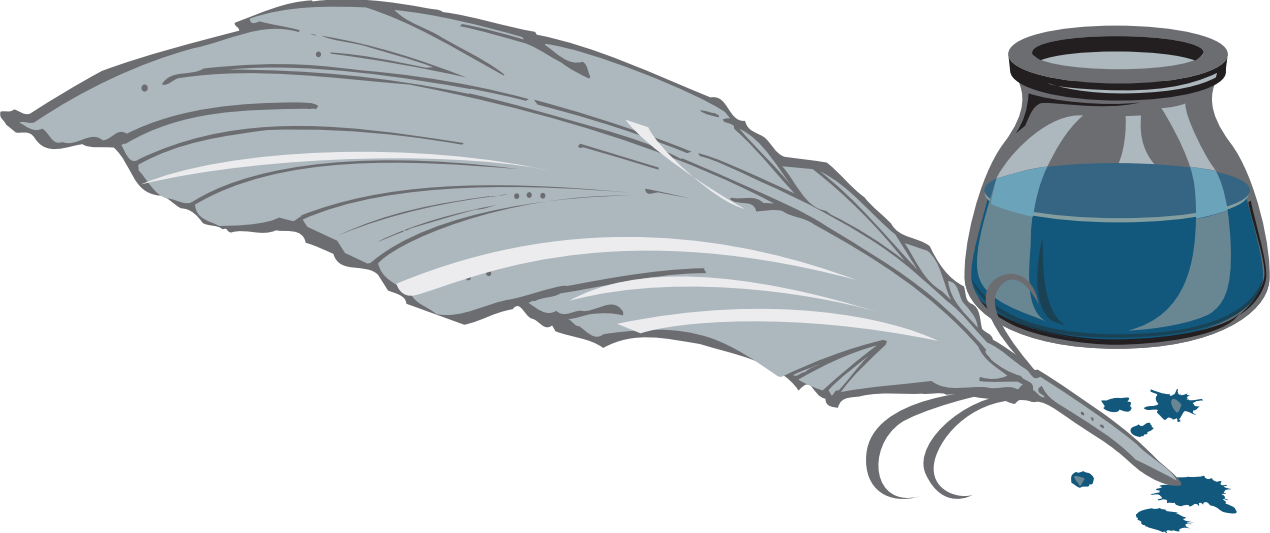

Keep a list of local taxi company phone numbers on hand and encourage guests who plan to consume alcohol to use ridesharing apps to get to and from the party.

Fourth of July festivities typically are less formal than other celebrations, but hosts still must plan their parties to ensure everyone has a fun, safe Independence Day.

A SIZZLING SUMMER MEAL

Summertime, for many, represents an opportunity to enjoy freshly cooked meals while enjoying time outdoors. Taking your dishes from ordinary to extraordinary starts with chef-inspired recipes that call to mind the flavors of the season.

If you're a summer burger connoisseur looking for a fresh twist on tradition, this recipe calls for high-quality beef, these Fried Lobster Po Boy Burgers with pimento remoulade sauce are a tempting way to combine two summertime favorites - seafood and burgers.

Fried Lobster Po Boy Burgers

Recipe courtesy of Chef David Rose  
Prep time: about 20 minutes  
Cook time: about 20 minutes  
Servings: 2

Pimento Remoulade:

½ cup mayonnaise  
1 ½ tablespoons minced pimentos  
1 tablespoon Dijon mustard  
1 tablespoon minced bread and butter pickles  
1 pepperoncino (seeded and minced)  
¼ teaspoon smoked paprika  
¼ teaspoon garlic powder  
¼ teaspoon freshly ground black pepper  
1 tablespoon freshly squeezed lemon juice  
3 dashes hot sauce  
kosher salt, to taste

Fried Lobster Tails:

Vegetable oil, for frying  
½ cup all-purpose flour  
½ teaspoon kosher salt, divided  
½ teaspoon freshly ground black pepper, divided  
¼ teaspoon garlic



powder  
¼ teaspoon smoked paprika  
1 large egg  
1 tablespoon water  
2 dashes hot pepper sauce  
¼ cup potato chips, finely blended in food processor  
1/3 cup panko breadcrumbs  
1 tablespoon minced flat leaf Italian parsley  
2 Omaha Steaks lobster tails (5 ounces each)

**Cheeseburgers:**  
1 pound Omaha Steaks premium ground beef  
salt, to taste  
freshly ground black pepper, to taste  
2 tablespoons unsalted butter, at room temperature  
2 brioche buns  
2 slices yellow cheddar cheese  
3 leaves romaine lettuce, shredded

**Instructions:**  
To make pimento remoulade: In small bowl, mix mayonnaise, pimentos, mustard, pickles, pepperoncino, paprika, garlic powder, black pepper, lemon juice and hot sauce until well incorporated. Season with salt, to taste.

To make fried lobster tails: Preheat grill to 400 F and add oil to 10-inch cast-iron pan about ½-inch deep.

In medium bowl,

whisk flour, ¼ teaspoon salt, ¼ teaspoon pepper, garlic powder and smoked paprika until well incorporated. Set aside.

In separate medium bowl, whisk egg, water and hot pepper sauce. Set aside.

In third medium bowl, whisk potato chips, panko breadcrumbs and parsley until well incorporated. Set aside.

Cut lobster tails in half lengthwise, remove meat from shell and season with remaining kosher salt and black pepper.

Toss halved lobster tails in flour mixture first, egg mixture second then potato chip mixture third, coating thoroughly.

Fry lobster tails 3-4 minutes on each side until golden brown and cooked through. Close grill lid between flipping.

To make cheeseburgers: Preheat grill to 450 F using direct heat. Form ground beef into two ½ pound patties, each about ½-inch thick.

Using thumb, make dimple in center of each patty to help cook evenly.

Season both sides of burger with salt and pepper, to taste.

Spread butter on each cut side of buns.

Grill burgers 4-5 minutes per side for medium doneness.

Add one slice cheddar cheese on each burger, close lid and grill about 30 seconds to melt cheese. Remove patties from grill to clean plate. Place buns cut sides down on grill grates and toast 20-30 seconds, or until well toasted, being careful to avoid burning.
