

'Spring Ahead' **One Hour** March 13

Daylight Saving Time In Effect

Daylight saving time in the U.S. will begin again on March 13, and ends on Nov. 6. Set your clocks ahead one-hour on Saturday night, March 12, before you go to sleep, or at 2 a.m.

Sunrise and sunset will be approximately one hour later on March 13 than the day before. There will be more light in the evening.

Burn Ban In Effect

March 16 - May 14

Open burning is the single greatest cause of wildfires in New York, according to the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC). Since the spring burn ban was implemented in 2009, the number of wildfires has decreased by more than 40%.

Open burning is prohibited in New York, with several exceptions:

- Campfires or any other outdoor fires less than three-feet in height and four-feet in length, width or diameter are allowed.
- Small cooking fires are allowed.
- Ceremonial or celebratory bonfires are allowed. Disposal of flags or religious items in a smallsized fire is allowed, if it is not otherwise prohibited by law or regulation.
- Only charcoal or dry, clean, untreated or unpainted wood can be burned.
- Fires cannot be left unattended and must be fully extinguished.

The New York state burn ban is effective March 16 through May 14.



Deer Season Is Over But The Hunt For Sheds Begins

As winter progresses through March, whitetail bucks shed their antlers as testosterone levels drop in response to lengthening days. When the snow begins to melt in late winter, some hunters and antler enthusiasts head out to the woods and fields in search of the hidden treasures.

Trying to find a shed antler among the brush and melting snow may seem like trying to find a needle in a haystack, but with some diligence and

be rewarded. Winter deer yards are good places to start. During bouts of extreme cold and snow, deer will congregate in lower elevation areas with good southern exposure and evergreen cover to break the wind. Experienced shed hunters scout these areas pre-season in hopes of increasing their odds. Be cautious not to begin searching too early. Deer may still be congregated on their winter ranges and susceptible to disturbance. Shed hunters should also refrain from making "antler traps," which are baited devices intended to snag

practice, your efforts may

an antler as the deer feeds. Not only is it illegal to feed deer, but these devices can cause antlers to be pulled off prematurely, potentially leading to infection and slow death of the deer.

Shed hunting can be a fun family activity and a rewarding reason to get outdoors in late winter and early spring. As hunters choose to "Let Young Bucks Go and Watch Them Grow," shed hunting can also provide clues as to what type of bucks might be around during next hunting season.

Give it a try, you might discover your next hobby.



Level: Beginner

Create a better bird habitat. Choose a variety of native plants to make your area welcoming for many of our state's 450 species of birds.

Take part in the I Bird NY Challenges when offered by DEC. These challenges have levels appropriate for both beginning and experienced birders. You can track your progress and you may just be surprised by the feathered friends you identify.

Look for birding events through DEC. State Parks also offers birding events on occasion - visit their events webpage. Opportunities are often available both in-person and virtually to learn more.

Join a birding club or organization. Meet others with similar interests

and expand your birding knowledge.

Enjoy the variety - from large birds such as the wild turkey to small birds like the black-capped chickadee, there is an abundance of different species to admire.

The New York State Bird Conservation Area (BCA) Program was established in 1997 to safeguard and enhance bird populations - along with their habitats on state lands and waters.

There are 59 designated BCA sites in New York. The BCA Program is modeled after the National Audubon Society's Important Bird Areas (IBA) program, which began in New York in 1996.

A Breeding Bird Atlas oc-

curs every 20 years in New York. Birders of all backgrounds are invited to take part from 2020 to 2024. This third atlas will continue to improve our understanding of changes in the distribution of breeding birds in the state and provide the basis for more informed conservation and management of birds and their habitats. Learn more about the project and how to participate.
