New Disc Golf Course Brings Outdoor Fun to Mosinee

New Project offers a fresh opportunity for kids and families to be active.

Local community member and middle school Physical Education and Health teacher Don Winter has taken the initiative to bring an exciting new recreational option to Mosinee by developing a brand-new disc golf course. Designed to provide a healthy, family-friendly activity for kids and adults alike, the course is expected to open on May 7th.

Located at River Park, the course will feature 9 beginner holes thoughtfully laid out to challenge players while welcoming beginners. The purpose of this course is to create more opportunities for young people to stay active, spend time outdoors, and engage with others in their community. The course also provides a safe place for kids to hang out.

"I wanted to give kids in Mosinee something fun and positive to do outside," said Don Winter, the project's lead. "Disc golf is a great way to enjoy nature, stay active, and spend quality time with friends or family. Plus, it's affordable and easy to learn."

The project has already received enthusiastic support from residents and community leaders. The Mosinee PTO, MAAC, and Mosinee Middle and High School have supported this program from the start.

Disc golf continues to grow in popularity across the U.S. thanks to its accessibility, low cost, and appeal to all ages. This course will add to the town's growing list of recreational amenities and is expected

to attract visitors from surrounding areas.

The course will be open to the public and free to play during park hours, but will close during events such as the Fourth of July Celebration, Log Jam Festival, and other major community events hosted near River Park. An opening day celebration (Ribbon Cutting) is in the works and set for Wednesday, May 7th. 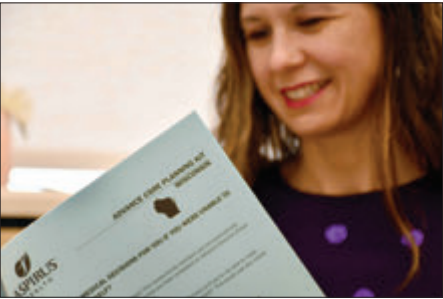
Who will speak for you?

were made. It can also prevent delays and costly legal expenses.

“If you don’t have an Advance Directive that names your Power of Attorney for Healthcare, the case may go to court, which can delay treatment decisions and cost thousands of dollars,” said Barge. “In addition, if your loved ones don’t agree on your care plan, it can cause a lot of stress.”

When choosing a health care agent or advocate, you need to consider who will honor your wishes, even if they don’t agree with them. Who can handle stress and will be a good advocate for you? As life changes, a new document should be completed to reflect your current choices, values, and wishes.

Completing an advance directive may be easy for some and difficult for others. Aspirus offers free assistance with trained facilitators either in person, via phone, or virtually.

“We go through the form and answer your questions,” said Barge. “We can help you think about scenarios you may not have thought about and discuss what your wishes would be. The document is then scanned into your medical record, you keep the original, and we can make copies for you at no charge.”

Advance care planning kits are available in our clinics, hospitals, and at aspirus.org/advance-directives. You may also request a kit be mailed to you by calling our Aspirus Customer Contact Center at 800-847-4707.

Annual Conference Awards and Recognition Ceremony on Saturday, April 12.

The Trail Steward of the Year Award honors individuals whose work in any phase of Trail management contributes in “an extraordinary manner” to the development and care of the Ice Age National Scenic Trail. It celebrates excellence in Trail planning, design, construction, maintenance, landowner and partner relations, and stewardship work.

Over the past year, Krause, who lives in Weston, contributed more than 800 volunteer hours to Trail-related activities—more than

600 of which were devoted to Trail maintenance. Whether working quietly behind the scenes as a tool manager and segment maintainer for the Central Moraines Chapter of the Alliance or stepping up to support major construction efforts across the state, Krause’s commitment has left a lasting impact.

“Jerry is the kind of volunteer every organization dreams of: humble, dependable, and skilled,” says Luke Kloberdanz, Executive Director and CEO of the Ice Age Trail Alliance. “He shows up early, stays late, and brings a quiet leadership that inspires everyone around him.”

Krause is a go-to resource when complex Trail construction projects arise. His craftsmanship and technical know-how ensure projects are completed to the highest standards.

He has led multiple Eagle Scout projects and worked closely with two WisCorps crews over the past year, sharing his expertise and

instilling Trail values in the next generation of conservation stewards.

Beyond construction and maintenance, Krause is a trusted presence for staff and volunteers alike. Just a phone call away, he routinely arrives early to prep projects and sticks around after the work is done to tie up loose ends—often serving as a reliable, on-the-ground partner when staff is unavailable.

In addition to volunteering for the Alliance and creating

and maintaining the Trail, Krause is also an Ice Age Trail Thousand Miler; he

completed the entire Ice Age Trail by section hiking it in 2016.

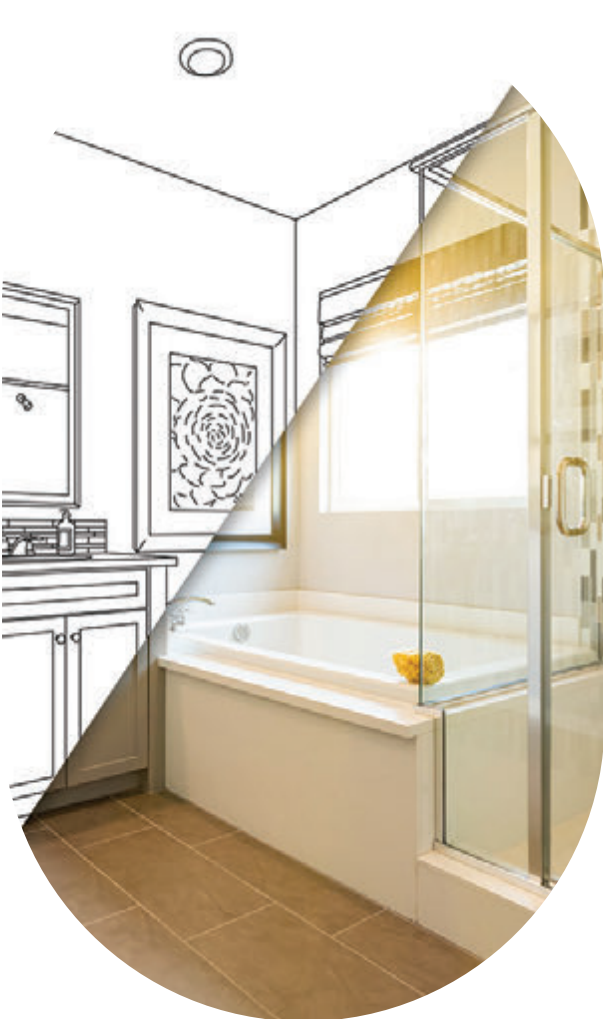

How to Prepare for a Lengthy Renovation Project



Home renovations can increase resale value and outfit spaces to make them more accommodating to residents. Homeowners interested in remodeling projects understand that such undertakings are often a lengthy process. But the time spent waiting often is well worth it when the work is done and the finished product looks just as homeowners imagined.

Depending on the scope and scale of a project, home renovations can take anywhere from a day or two for minor cosmetic changes to nine months for a major project. months. Homeowners weary of such lengthy undertakings can implement strategies to make conditions at home more manageable.

■ **Get a rough estimate from contractors so that you can budget accordingly.** A project will go nowhere without proper funding. Get

detailed estimates that include labor and building materials. Then start saving and stash money away for the project so you're not caught off-guard later on.

■ **Clear out clutter.** Remove any extraneous items from the room or rooms that will be remodeled. Although it

will be an added expense, it is a good idea to rent a storage unit or have a storage pod placed in the driveway or yard for the duration of the project. Move items that will not be needed into the unit. This will get them out of the way and protect them from damage.

■ **Consider starting in warm weather.**

Contractors will be going in and out of the home each day, and doors and windows may need to be propped open. Schedule a project during those months when temperatures are more comfortable. If the project involves limited access to the kitchen to cook, utilizing an outdoor grill or kitchen is much easier when the weather is pleasant.

■ **Stay with relatives.** While some people have no issues living in a residence during a renovation, others may find the work simply too inconvenient or distracting to be around. Time away from the property can help manage stress, and prevent kids, pets and others from getting in the way of work.

■ **Safeguard sensitive items.** Take inventory of items in the home and catalog them for insurance purposes. This way you're covered in the case of damage or theft. Remove documents, like birth certificates, passports, insurance policies, and other private papers, and keep them in a safety deposit box or fireproof safe.

Home renovations may stretch on for weeks or months. However, with adequate preparation, homeowners can see such projects through without facing too much adversity.

Tips to Renovate on a Budget

Renovations around the house require an investment of time and often considerable amounts of money. Findings from the 2024 U.S. Houzz & Home Study show that home renovations are becoming more expensive. The median renovation spending for homeowners has gone up 60 percent since 2020. Angi, a home services website, reports the average renovation cost for homes between 1,250 and 1,600 square feet is \$51,772, but the final cost of home renovations depends on the scope of the project.

Homeowners who are conserving funds can rest assured that it is possible to make meaningful changes both inside and outside a home without breaking the bank. Here are some ways to renovate a home on a budget.

- **Create a budget and don't waver.** Figure out exactly what you can

afford for a renovation and then make that your maximum dollars spent. Research comparable projects in your area and be honest about whether you can afford the renovation as-is or if you must adapt ideas to fit your price. Make sure to build in a cushion of around 15 to 20 percent for any unforeseen expenses that may arise once a renovation is underway.

- **Maximize an existing floor plan.** This Old House suggests looking for ways to maximize your current layout before you invest in major renovations like an expansion. Bring in a designer with an eye for utilizing space. For example, see how you might be able to replace shelves with pull-out drawers in the kitchen. Moving furniture around or rethinking floor plans also can help to lower costs.
- **Balance DIY with hiring contractors.**

You can save money by tackling some projects yourself, but only if you are confident in your renovation skills. Rather than risk making costly mistakes and having to redo things, hire well-vetted professionals but ask if there's any DIY work you can do to cut costs.

- **Check clearance and resale stores.** Shop discount stores for building materials to save money. For example, if a builder ordered too many cabinets they may offer them to Habitat for Humanity ReStores, which are nonprofit home improvement stores and donation centers. Checking the clearance and markdown sections

of other stores may yield considerable savings on items needed for a renovation. Warehouse retailers like Costco or Sam's Club also can be great places to find certain home improvement materials and furnishings.

- **Take advantage of free services.** Certain stores may offer things like free consultations

with designers who can show you what a renovation can look like. This is advantageous to the stores because once you see the potential you're more likely to buy the products, even if it's not mandatory.

- **Resurface instead of redo.** Certain items can be made to look new with minimal effort. Paint

is a relatively inexpensive tool that can transform walls and more. A good hardwood flooring company can buff out a floor and put a new coating instead of an entirely new floor. Kitchen cabinets can be resurfaced instead of replaced as well. Finding ways to perform home renovations on a budget may require some creative thinking, but it's possible to get results at the right price point.

4 Things to Know About Kitchen Renovations



Kitchens are often described as the most popular room in a home, and that's not mere conjecture. A 2022 survey from House Digest asked participants to identify the room they consider most important in their homes, and roughly 41 percent chose the kitchen.

Residents tend to congregate in kitchens in the morning and then

again in the evening when meals are prepared and, in homes without formal dining rooms, eaten. With so much time spent in the kitchen, it's no wonder that the 2022 U.S. Houzz & Home Study: Renovation Trends found kitchens to be the most popular interior room to upgrade. With so many people interested in kitchen renovations, the

following are four things homeowners should know about these popular improvement projects.

1. Expect to spend some money. Most home improvement projects require a significant financial investment, but kitchen renovations are among the more expensive undertakings. The overall cost of a

project will depend on a host of variables unique to each home, including homeowners' preferences, but HomeAdvisor estimated the average kitchen remodel in 2023 cost between \$14,611 and \$41,432. Homeowners considering an upscale kitchen remodel may receive six figure estimates for such projects.

2. Expect a good return on investment. If sticker shock settles in when receiving an initial kitchen remodel estimate, perhaps it can help homeowners to know that such a project may provide a strong return on investment (ROI). According to Remodeling magazine's "2024 Cost vs. Value Report," a minor kitchen remodel provides a 96 percent ROI. A major

kitchen remodel mid-range (49 percent) and a major kitchen remodel upscale (38 percent) did not provide as notable a ROI.

3. Expect the project to take some time. Kitchens are large rooms with a lot of components, so renovating these spaces can take some time. Estimates vary depending on the size of the room, the scale of the remodel and the materials chosen, but Angi reports a kitchen remodel for most homes takes six weeks to four months. That's a sizable window, and it reflects the likelihood that unforeseen issues like supply chain interruptions or the discovery of mold will arise at some point during the renovation. Though it's impossible to determine precisely how long a project will take before it begins, homeowners renovating

their kitchens may want to plan for the project to take two months if not longer.

4. Expect to use your kitchen during the renovation. If the timeline of a renovation is scary, homeowners should know they will likely be able to use their kitchen even after the project begins. Though the room might not remain a popular gathering space once the work starts, Angi notes kitchens are typically out of commission for around six weeks during a renovation. That still requires some pre-planning in relation to meals, but it also suggests homeowners won't be without a kitchen for months on end.

Kitchen renovations are popular projects. Homeowners who know what to expect before such projects commence can make it through a renovation more smoothly.
