The distinctively hazy ale will be available on tap at Coppertail and at Fins Cantina at The Florida Aquarium.



Coral Haze is a turbid, unfiltered pale ale, which is hop forward in its fruitiness and aroma. The haze is a by-product of unfiltered beer with heavy late hop additions that creates a creamy mouthfeel.

Proceeds from every pint of Coral Haze will go to The Florida Aquarium to assist their critical conservation efforts. A release party is set for Friday, May 11, at 4 PM at Coppertail. Florida Aquarium's CEO, Roger Germann, will pull the first pint of Coral Haze.
