ATTACHMENT I - STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT:

The Affiant swears to the following facts to establish probable cause for the issuance of a search warrant:

The request for this search warrant is submitted based on the following evidence and credentials. The Affiant, Sergeant Derek Toney, has been a sworn Law Enforcement Officer with Cleveland County Sheriff's Office since 2012. From 2012 to 2014, the Affiant was assigned to the Patrol Division as a patrol deputy. The daily operations with the Sheriff's Office Patrol Division included the following: the service of misdemeanor and felony warrants, investigation of crimes, enforcement of traffic laws, and all other calls for service. From 2014-2016 the Affiant was assigned to the Narcotics Division on the Community Interdiction Team. The Affiant's daily operations included the following: recognition and enforcement of narcotic laws, investigation of narcotic/vice complaints, patrolling high crime/high drug areas, drafting and service of various types of search warrants. From 2016 to 2018 the Affiant served as a Field Training Officer on the Patrol Division within the Sheriff's Office. The Affiant's daily tasks include the training of newly sworn Sheriff's Deputies on state law and departmental policy. From 2018 to 2023 the affiant served as a Narcotics Investigator, the Affiant's daily operations included the following: recognition and enforcement of narcotic laws, investigation of narcotic/vice complaints, undercover operations, managing confidential informants, and conducting controlled buys of illegal narcotics through the use of confidential informants or undercover officers. In 2023 the affiant was promoted to the rank of Sergeant and assigned to the Criminal Investigation Division. The affiant's daily operations include the supervision of the investigation into crimes against persons, property crimes, and other crimes, which may include the recovery and/or identification of evidence indication an association between a suspect and victim.

The Affiant has an associate in applied science degree in the field of Criminal Justice. The Affiant has over 1800 law enforcement training hours and some of the Affiant's relevant training include: Narcotics Investigator Schools, Police Law Institute, Recognition training, Clandestine Laboratory Safety, Managing

The information contained within this affidavit is based upon information the affiant has gained from this investigation, the affiant's personal observations, training, and experience, and/or information relayed to the affiant by other law enforcement officers and/or agents. Since this affidavit is being submitted for the limited purpose of securing a search warrant, the affiant has not included each and every fact known to him concerning this investigation.

The Affiant swears to the following facts to establish probable cause for the issuance of a search warrant:

The information received during the course of this investigation is discussed in this affidavit and is believed to be true and accurate by Sergeant Derek Toney of the Cleveland County Sheriff's Office.

- 1. On February 14, 2000, 9-year-old Asha Jaquilla Degree, went missing from her home in Shelby, North Carolina. Asha Degree was seen by drivers walking along North Carolina Highway 18 in Shelby, North Carolina. Asha Degree was seen being pulled into a 1970's green Lincoln, Thunderbird, or another similar vehicle. Asha Jaquilla Degree has not been seen since that time.
- 2. On August 2, 2001, evidence belonging to Asha Degree was located in Burke County, NC, on the side of Highway 18, approximately 21 miles north of where Asha Degree was last seen. A construction crew working in the area located the evidence and turned it over to the Cleveland County Sheriff's Office.
- 3. Numerous items of evidence were collected from the area; some having been identified as belonging to Asha Degree and other items not belonging to Asha Degree.
- 4. Various items of evidence were sent for analysis. Two of those items returned evidentiary results. Genealogical data narrowed the samples down to two (2) individuals. One sample belonged to Russell Bradley Underhill. Another sample belonged to a hereditary family member of suspects Roy Lee Dedmon and Connie Elliott Dedmon.

- 5. Investigators determined Russell Bradley Underhill lived in at least one facility operated by Roy Lee Dedmon and Connie Elliott Dedmon, during the time Asha Degree was reported as a missing person. Russell Bradley Underhill was discovered deceased in Lincoln County in 2004.
- 6. Roy Lee Dedmon and Connie Elliott Dedmon share three (3) children in common, identified as Lizzie Grace Dedmon Foster, Sarah Gwen Dedmon Caple and AnnaLee Victoria Dedmon Ramirez. The oldest daughter, Lizzie Grace Dedmon Foster, resides in Texas. The middle daughter, Sarah Gwen Dedmon Caple, resides in Shelby, North Carolina and the youngest daughter, AnnaLee Victoria Dedmon Ramirez, resides in Charlotte, North Carolina.
- 7. Laboratory analysis of collected DNA samples indicated the likelihood that the hair stem sample from Asha Degree's undershirt is a person genetically identical to the DNA standard collected from AnnaLee Victoria Dedmon Ramirez. AnnaLee Victoria Dedmon Ramirez is a hereditary family member (daughter) of suspects Roy Lee Dedmon and Connie Elliott Dedmon.
- 8. On February 14, 2000, the ages of the three (3) common Dedmon children would have been: Lizzie Grace Dedmon Foster (16 years of age), Sarah Gwen Dedmon Caple (15 years of age), and AnnaLee Victoria Dedmon Ramirez (13 years of age).
- O. Due to the ages of Roy Dedmon and Connie Dedmon's three daughters in the year of 2000, Investigators believe adult assistance from Roy Dedmon and Connie Dedmon would have been necessary in the execution and/or concealment of the crime.
- 10. Suspects Roy Lee Dedmon and spouse, Connie Elliott Dedmon, currently reside at separate residences from one another.
- 11. Roy Dedmon and Connie Dedmon are the two common links between the profiles of Russell Bradley Underhill and AnnaLee Victoria Dedmon Ramirez, collected and identified, from Asha Degree's undershirt and the trash bag which contained Asha Degree's bookbag.


